
Error during installing Mixit2 / MX2000 / LCD2000 on WINDOWS VISTA 32bits on a Windows Vista 32bits PC and solution of the error

SUBJECT: Error during installing Mixit2 / MX2000 / LCD2000 on Windows VISTA 32bits on a Windows Vista 32bits PC

PROGRAM: Mixit2 / MX2000 / LCD2000

VERSION: 1.91

PROBLEM

During installing the Mixit2 / MX2000 / LCD2000 software Mixit2 tries to install the formula database.
The following error message occurs:

“Could not create C:\users\MixitL~1\AppData\Local\Temp\TMP.arc

It is known that this error message sometimes occurs during installation of Mixit2 / Mixit 2000 / LCD2000 on Windows XP.

CAUSE

This error message occurs when Mixit is unable to write to the system temporary folder C:\TEMP

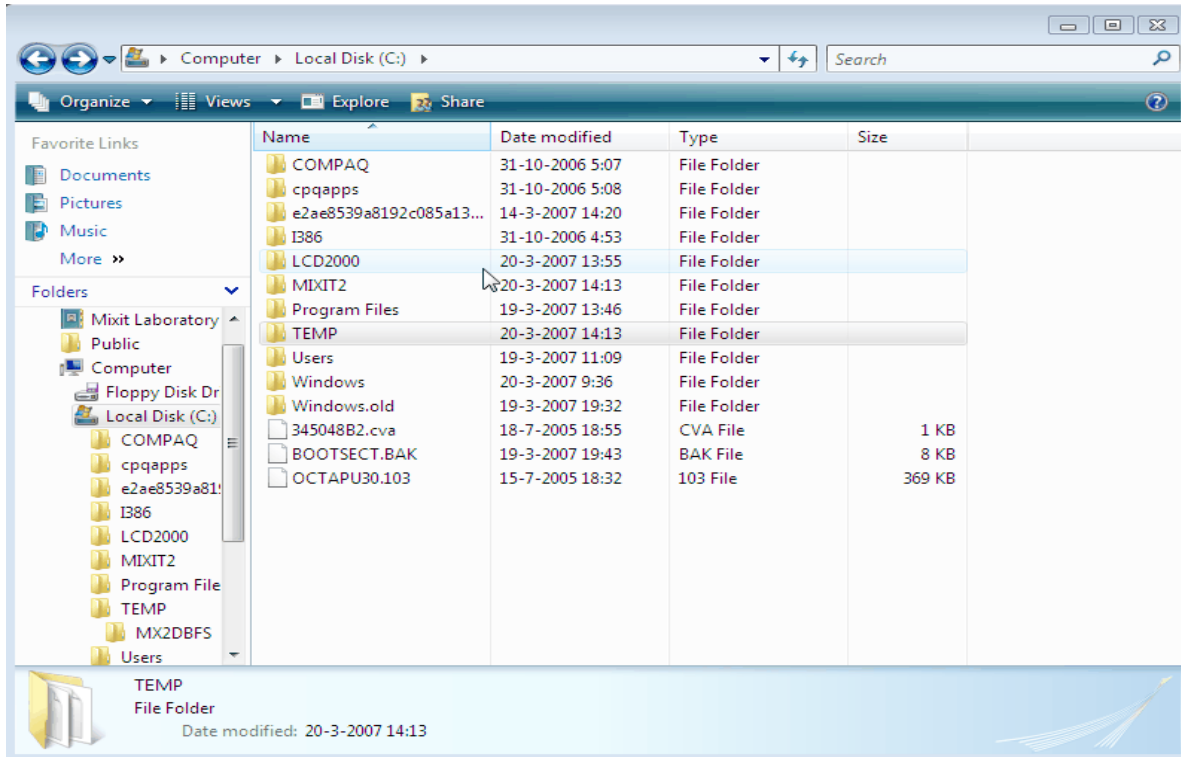
SOLUTION

1. Create the folder C:\TEMP
2. Change the Systems User variable value of TEMP in C:\TEMP
3. Reboot the computer
4. Install the Mixit software and database
5. Mixit2 own colors and Automatchic worklists

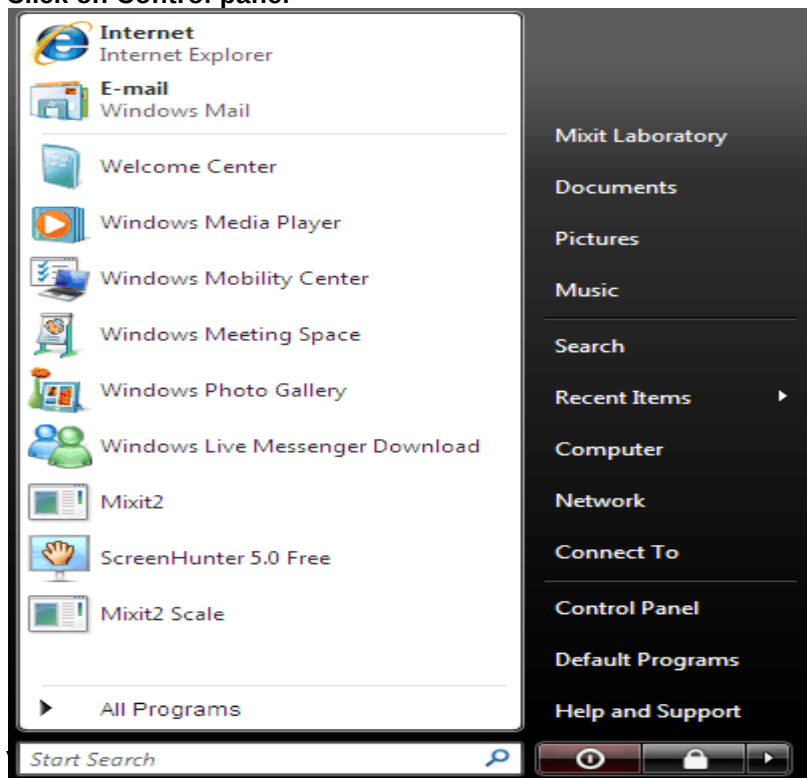
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1. Create the folder C:\TEMP



2. Change the Systems User variable value of TEMP in C:\TEMP

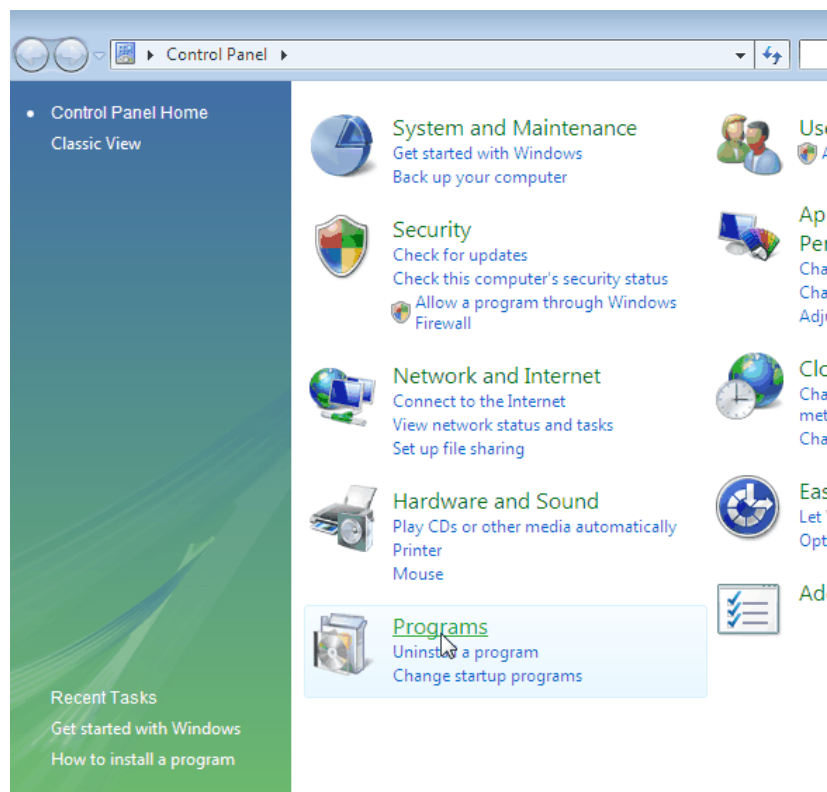
Click on Control panel



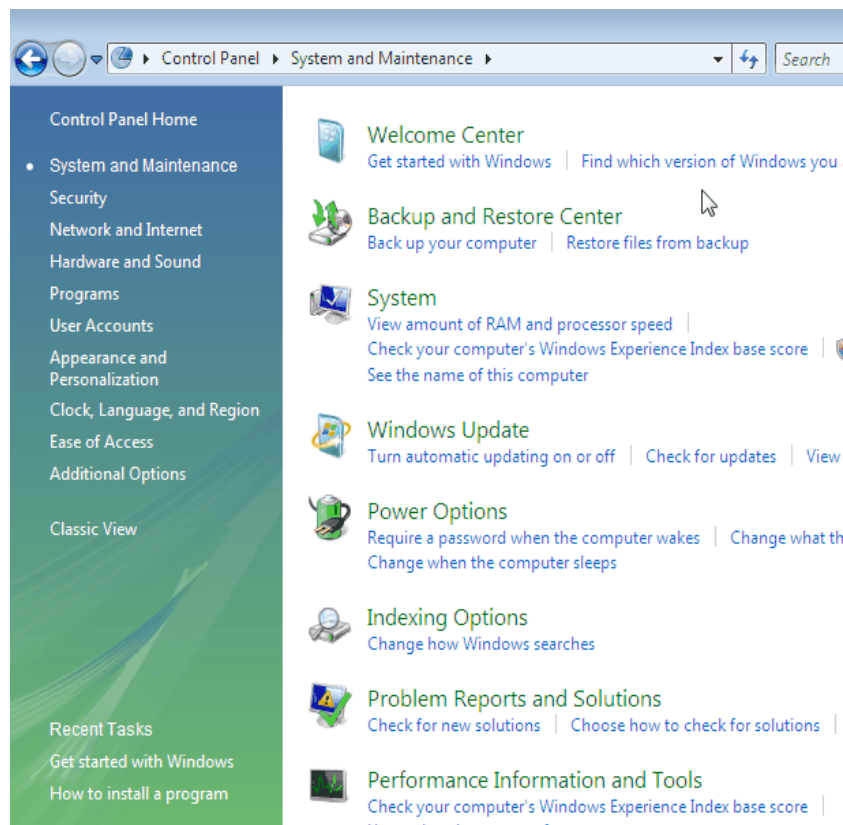

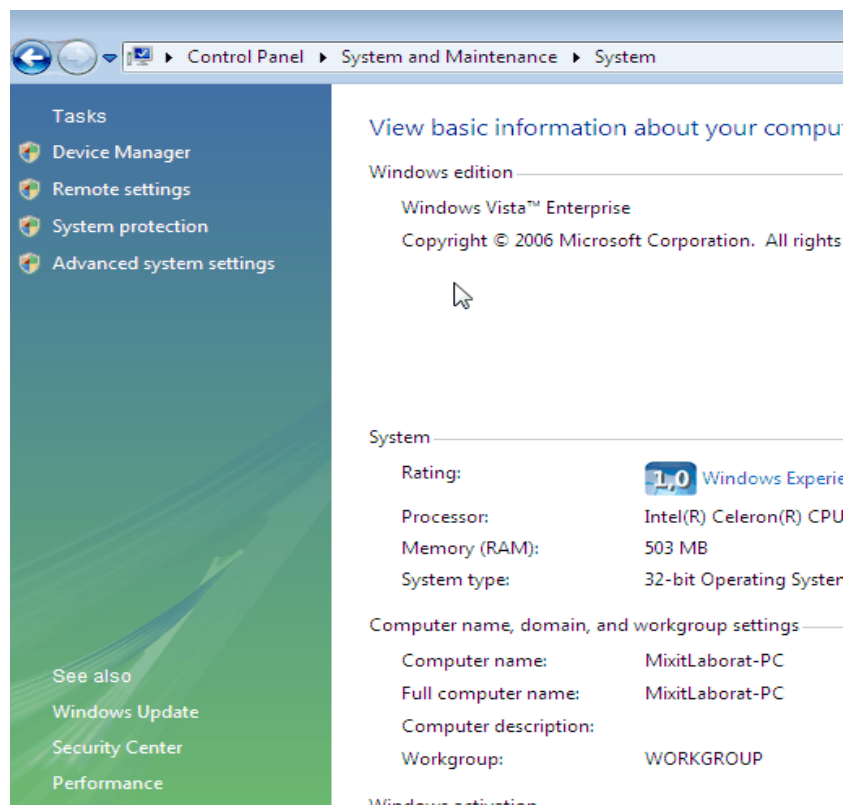

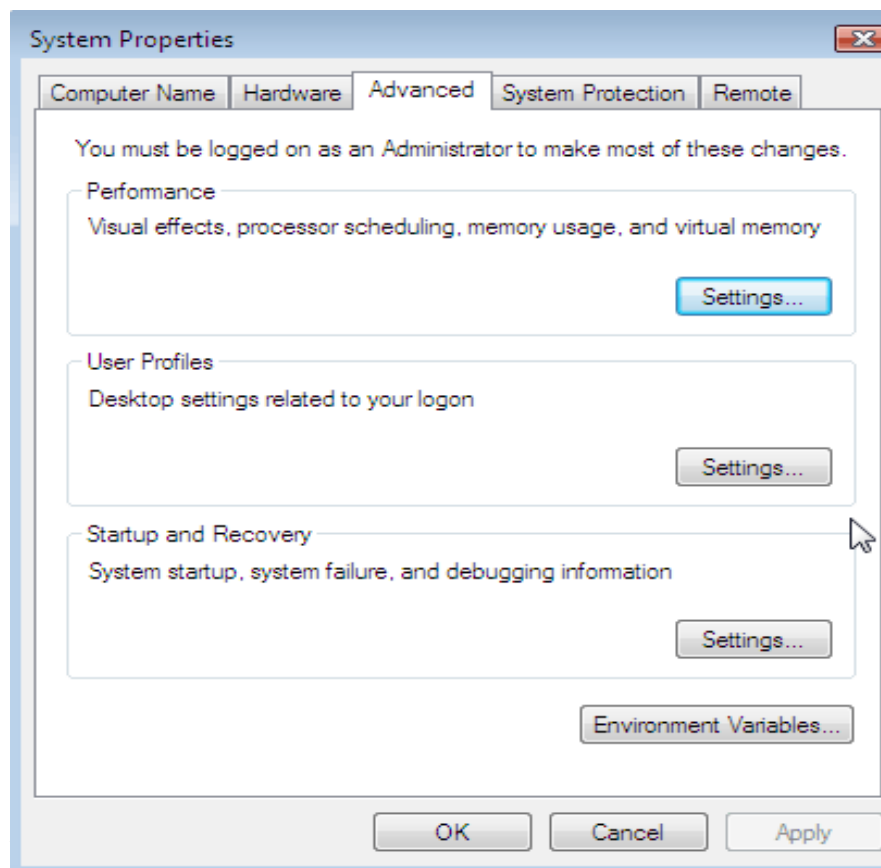
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On theTasks menu click on Advanced system Settings



This will bring up the User account control window => Click on continue

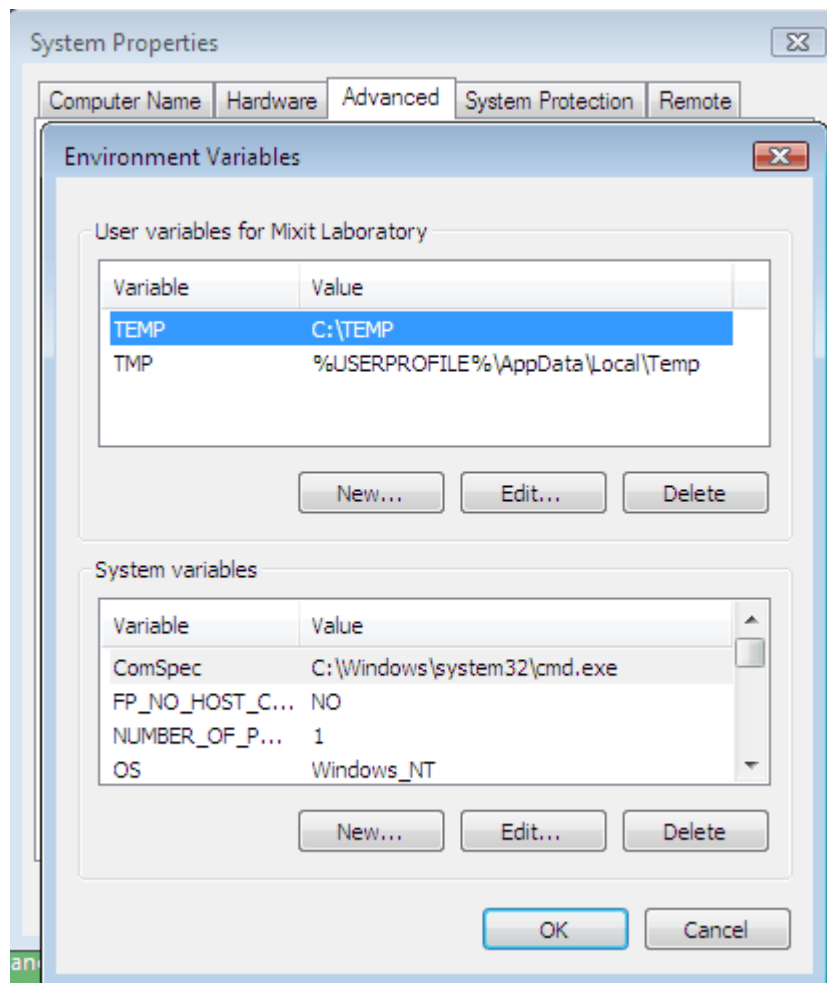
This will bring up the following screen:

Click on Environment Variables

You should now see a screen that looks similar to the following (see *)



Make sure that TEMP is highlighted, then click Edit.

Change the Variable Value to C:\TEMP

(*) NOTE: in the above shown screen the variable value has already been changed into C:\TEMP

Click OK (2 times) and close the Control panel > System & Maintenance > System screen

3. Reboot the Computer.

4. Install the Mixit software and database.

5. Mixit2 own colors and Automatchic worklists

Please also be aware of the fact that Mixit2 Own Colors and Worklist can't be stored in the root of the PCs harddrive (C:\). The solution is to store own colors and worklists in the Mixit2 directory (C:\Mixit2) or in subdirectories of C:\Mixit2
